The elements that make up the baseline solution are:

Functional Element	Description
Home Page Template	Houses content that is largely applicable to all users.
File share indexing	Up to a maximum of 5 file shares in the company will be indexed.
RSS Feeds	3 RSS Feed web parts will be provided by default, with the customer able to add more.
Divisional Unit Template	A generic site template used for various business units, i.e. HR, Sales, Marketing, etc.
Classifieds	A section for "Classifieds" type information will be added to the home page.
Setup search groups	The default search groups will be enhanced to allow users to search file shares, messaging infrastructure & external sites.
Daily Comic	A daily released comic (such as Dilbert) will be displayed via a web part on the homepage and updated daily.
Metadata	Standard metadata is applied throughout the portal (up to 8 metadata fields).
Divisional Blog	Each division will have one blog set up, i.e. Marketing → Marketing Blog
Divisional Events Calendar	Each division will have an events calendar accessible by all users.
Company Announcements	Announcements are managed on the home page, maintained by the home page author.
Divisional Announcements	Announcements relevant to each business unit are managed on the divisional site.
